

## WHA POLICIES AND PROCEDURES BY OFFICERS AND/OR MEMBERSHIP

- **Regular meetings:** Regular meetings are held on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month at the Waldo Library. The exceptions being when events are held on regular meeting days.
- **Personal Announcements:** Personal petitions, causes, announcements or participation in events are welcomed to be announced by any member with transactions and discussions to take place after the meeting, not as a topic during the meeting. (2005)
- **Welcome Bags:** We encourage distribution of “Welcome Bags” to any and all new neighbors (renters and owners alike). The initiative should be taken by a current member neighbor to the Welcome Bag contact to obtain a “Welcome Bag” and deliver it to the new neighbor. (2005)
- **Refreshments:** We have no volunteer to be a “Refreshments Committee.” The group (members and officers) agreed at the March 2005 meeting that there is no expectation of coffee and treats to be provided. If someone feels like bringing treats to share, that is wonderful. If nobody brings treats, there will be no complaints. (2005)
- **WABA Liaison:** Laurie, Hines, Past WHA President, and member of the Waldo Area Business Association (WABA), by request of the current officers agreed to provide a WABA update to the membership at the monthly meetings. (2005)
- **CPAC Liaison:** Anita Hill, Past WHA Vice President, by request of the current officers agreed to continue to attend the CPAC meetings and provide a Police/Crime report to the membership at the monthly meetings. (2005)
- **Volunteer Banquet:** When a volunteer banquet is held, members who have worked a minimum of 2 volunteer hours during the year will have their dinner free. (2004)
